Septage Disposal Survey

GOWA is in the process of conducting a comprehensive survey on septage disposal. This could be the biggest thing GOWA has ever done and the most revealing. Below are the questions we asked. Go to our website to take the survey at www.onsitewastewater.org.

I was hoping to have hundreds of responses so we could get a really good sampling of the problems we have with disposal of septage. But instead we had 30 people respond. To someone outside the industry, this might indicate that there is **NO problem** with disposal of septage!

Be sure to read the letter from Athens / Clark Co. about this.

There is still time to respond to this survey.

8. Does your home county/city treatment facility accept septage from outside their co. or city lines?
9. How does your home county charge?
10. How many gallons can you dispose of in one day at the treatment facility ?
11. How many gallons can you dispose of in one day with a hauler you use ?

12. If they charge so much per 1,000 gals, how much do they charge?
13. If they charge so much per 1,000 gals, how much did they charge one year ago?
14. Does your home county accept septic only / gray water only from grease?
15. If they do accept it, do they price it unreasonably high to discourage you from taking it there?
16. How far do you have to drive to dispose of septage
17. How many gallons of septage on average does your company pump per day?
18. How many truck loads of septage on average does your company pump per day?
19. How do you pay to dispose of septage?
20. How much do you pay per truck to dispose of septage per gallon?
21. How much do you pay per truck to dispose of septage per load?
22. Have you talked to your state representative and/or state senator about the problem you are having disposing of septage?
23. Do you have storage capacity on site or have to dump what you pump immediately, or other?
24. What counties do you know that do NOT accept septage?
25. What cities do you know that do NOT accept septage?
26. What is your base charge for pumping septage per 1,000 gals?
27. What is your base charge for pumping septage per 1,500 gals?
28. Do you take your septage to: a treatment plant, another hauler or land apply?
29. On your invoice, do you put how much it costs you to dispose of the septage?
30. Are you a member of GOWA?
31. If GOWA tried to address this problem in the Legislature, would you be willing to contribute to a Legislative Fund to finance it?



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Septage Survey Response

Dear Mr. Widener,

I received a copy of your survey and after reading through all of the questions, I was struck by **how very important this survey** and resulting information is. I am not an installer or pumper but I take care of our septage-receiving program for the **Athens-Clarke County Unified Government**. We receive septic tank and portables waste from both inside and outside Clarke County. Currently we receive between 3.5M and 4M gallons per year. I talk with our pumpers as they come in generally 2 or 3 times a week. I hear the good and the bad from them, what they are dealing with in the field, what is good, what is not. I hear all of them complaining about the problems they are having with grease and especially with wipes. Some of them talk about spending hours trying to punch through the wipes to be able to even begin to pump a tank.

I am also very aware of the fact that few facilities accept septic tank or portables waste. I have spoken with managers at WRFs in many counties and am told septic tank waste is not accepted for a variety of reasons. On one end of the spectrum, they say they are at, or almost at, capacity and cannot take the septage. On the other end of the spectrum, I hear that their plant got so messed up by septage that they couldn't stay in permit so they will never again take septage.

This year I began mapping every address manifested on every load disposed of at our facility with the exception of

portables. It is quite eye opening! This month alone we have received loads from septic tanks pumped as far away as **75 miles**. Currently our prices are extremely low (\$.04 in county and \$.10 out of county), as we have not changed them since 2002. This, however, is in the process of being revisited. I am sure we will see a price increase soon. That may result in fewer loads from such far away counties but we will see.

I certainly do not know what the answer is but I believe there is a huge communication gap in those supplying septic tank permits and those governing the removal of waste from those same permitted septic tanks. Or maybe that's the issue.... Maybe there is no one properly governing that end of the process. If we are going to continue to allow septic tanks to be installed then we must also, somehow, allow for the removal and disposal of that waste. If we cannot do that, then why are we still issuing septic tank permits? I hear from our pumpers all the time that they don't know what they would do if we did not accept septage.... From our county and others. So, just how do we get County and State Health Departments talking to Utilities Directors to work out the issue of "if we permit the tanks, the septage has to be accepted" ?

Update: a price increase has been approved and will go into effect August 1st. The new prices will be \$0.10/gallon for in county septic tank waste.... \$0.30/gallon for out of county waste....\$0.30/gallon for portables waste regardless of point of origin.



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
